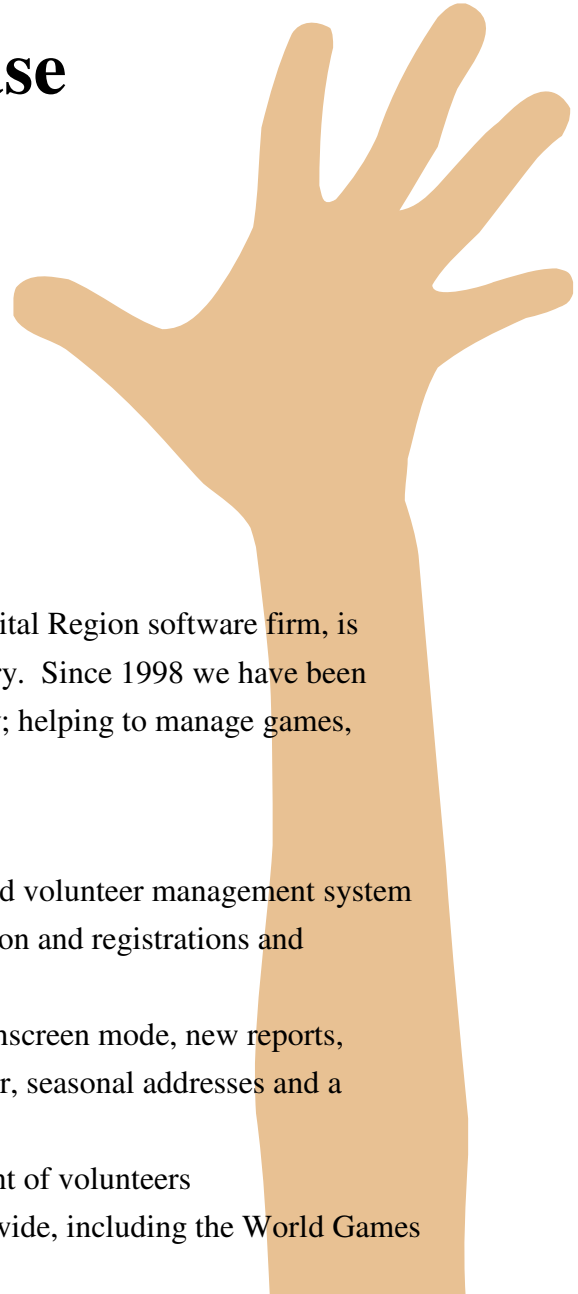

In 1999 it supplanted Oracle to manage the 1999 Special Olympics World Summer Games in Raleigh, North Carolina, and by the end of 2000, Special Olympics International licensed GMS for use by its chapters and competitions worldwide and has used GMS for all of their global events since.

In early 2007, Bespoke shipped its new volunteer management system, now in use across the United States and in Canada.
